24 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-FIRST GENERAL  
25 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

27 That the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission and the Oklahoma Department  
28 of Wildlife Conservation are hereby requested and urged to enter into  
29 reciprocal agreements whereby Arkansas residents who have been issued a senior  
30 citizens fishing license will be permitted to fish in Oklahoma based on their  
31 Arkansas license and likewise, Oklahoma citizens which have been issued on  
32 Oklahoma senior citizens fishing license will be authorized to engage in  
33 fishing in Arkansas based upon the Oklahoma license.
