16 WHEREAS, various methods of voting are allowed throughout the state and
17 the different systems cause confusion among voters; and

19 WHEREAS, the possibility of implementation of a uniform system of voting
20 should be examined to determine the potential advantages of such a system; and

22 WHEREAS, many voters have become interested in having a comprehensive
23 program for voting by mail,

25 NOW THEREFORE,

26 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-FIRST GENERAL
27 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

29 That the House and Senate Interim Committees on State Agencies and
30 Governmental Affairs are requested to conduct a study of the feasibility and
31 desirability of creating a statewide uniform system of voting and to study the
32 possibility of implementing a comprehensive program for voting by mail.
