19	WHEREAS, the recent tornados that devastated Arkansas have once again
20	indicated that an additional NOAA weather tracking site is necessary to
21	provide adequate coverage to southwest Arkansas; and
22	WHEREAS, adequate notice of an approaching tornado literally means the
23	difference between life and death; and
24	WHEREAS, many portions of southwest Arkansas do not now get adequate
25	warning of approaching tornados; and
26	WHEREAS, it is part of the mission and responsibility of NOAA to provide
27	adequate warning of approaching tornados;

29	NOW THEREFORE,
30	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-FIRST GENERAL
31	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

33	THAT the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, United States
34	Department of Commerce is hereby requested to establish a severe weather
35	tracking site at a location that will provide adequate coverage for the
36	residents of southwest Arkansas.

2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: THAT upon the adoption of this resolution that a copy hereof be 5 transmitted by the Chief Clerk of the House to Mr. D. James Baker, Under 6 Secretary of Commerce for Oceans and Atmosphere and Administrator of the 7 National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, and to each member of 8 Arkansas Congressional delegation.
