23	WHEREAS, Carnall Hall was named for Ella Carnall, who faithfully served
24	the University of Arkansas for four years as its first female professor; and
25	WHEREAS, Carnall Hall is a well known University structure which is
26	important to the history of women at the University of Arkansas;

30	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-FIRST GENERAL
