16	PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE FEDERAL		
17	CONSTITUTION TO LIMIT THE TERMS OF

20	WHEREAS, the people of the State of Arkansas having amended	the Stat	te
21	Constitution to limit their Representatives to Congress to serving	three	
22	two-year terms and their Senators to Congress to serving two six-year	ear term	ms,
23	other States also limiting the terms their delegations to Congress	may se	rve;
24			
25	WHEREAS, the United States Supreme Court decreed in the case	of Arka	ansas
26	vs. Thornton, that the terms of members elected to the United Stat	es Congi	ress
27	may be limited only by Amendment to the United States Constitution	;

29	WHEREAS, the people of the various States have consistently		
30	demonstrated, at the ballot box and in opinion polls, their overwh	elming	
31	desire to limit the terms of members serving in the United States	Congress	s;
32			
33	WHEREAS, under Article V of the Constitution of the United S	tates,	
34	amendments to the Federal Constitution may be proposed by the Cong	ress	
35	whenever two thirds of both Houses deem it necessary, or on the app	plicatio	on of
36	the legislatures of two thirds of the several states the Congress	shall ca	all a

1 Convention for the purpose of proposing amendments. We believe such action 2 vital; 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-FIRST GENERAL 5 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE SENATE, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS 6 ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO: THAT this body proposes to the Congress of the United States that 9 procedures be instituted in the Congress to add a new Article to the 10 Constitution of the United States, and that the General Assembly of the State 11 of Arkansas request the Congress to prepare and submit to the several states 12 an amendment to the Constitution of the United States, to limit the terms of 13 Representatives and the Senators serving in the United States Congress; and 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, alternatively, this body makes application 15 16 and requests that the Congress of the United States call a Convention for 17 proposing amendments to the United States Constitution; and 18 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT this body also proposes that the 20 legislatures of each of the several states comprising the United States apply 21 to the Congress requesting the proposal of an appropriate amendment to the 22 Federal Constitution, or requiring the Congress to call a Convention for 23 proposing such an amendment to the Federal Constitution; and 24 2.5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT copies of this Resolution be sent by the 26 Secretary of State to the Arkansas Congressional Delegation; and 27 28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Secretary of State of the State of 29 Arkansas is directed to send copies of this Joint Resolution to the Secretary 30 of State and presiding officers of both Houses of the Legislature of each of
