19 WHEREAS, Baxter County has approximately 5,500 veterans of the United States
20 Armed Forces; and

21 WHEREAS, these veterans are assigned to the Little Rock Veterans
22 Hospital which means they must travel over 300 miles round trip to receive
23 medical care and services; and

24 WHEREAS, in many instances traveling this distance results in an undue
25 hardship on the veterans and their families;

27 NOW THEREFORE,

28 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-FIRST GENERAL
29 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

31 That the members of the Arkansas Congressional Delegation are hereby
32 requested to do everything within their power to provide medical services to
33 veterans through the Baxter County Regional Hospital.

34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon adoption of this Resolution the Chief
35 Clerk of the House of Representatives shall transmit a copy to each member of
36 the Arkansas Congressional Delegation.
