16	"TO CLARIFY THE METHOD OF USING THE
17	CONSUMER PRICE INDEX FOR REDETERMINING
18	THE RETIREMENT BENEFITS UNDER THE
19	JUDICIAL RETIREMENT SYSTEM."
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21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-8-223 is amended to read as follows:
24	"24-8-223. Redetermination of benefits.
25	(a) As used in this section:
26	(1) _System_ means the Arkansas Judicial Retirement System; and
27	(2) _The amount of the benefit otherwise payable_ means the full
28	amount of the monthly benefit that would be payable disregarding the
29

31	$\frac{(3)}{(2)}$ _Consumer price index_ means the Consumer Price Index for
32	All Urban Consumers, as determined by the United States Department of Labor,
33	in effect January 1, 1987. Should the consumer price index be reconstructed
34	subsequent to 1995 in a manner materially changing its character, the board of
35	trustees, after receiving the advice of the actuary, shall change the
36	application of the consumer price index so that, as far as practicable, the

- 1 intent of the use of the consumer price index shall be continued.
- 2 (b)(1) Each July 1, the system shall redetermine the amount of each
- 3 monthly benefit that has been payable by the system for at least twelve (12)
- 4 full calendar months. The redetermined amount shall be payable for the
- 5 following twelve (12) months.
- 6 (2) Subject to the maximum stated in subdivision (b)(3) of this
- 7 section, such redetermined amount shall be the amount of the benefit otherwise
- 8 payable on July 1, plus an increase of three percent (3%).
- 9 (3)(A) The redetermined amount shall not be more than the amount
- 10 of the benefit otherwise payable multiplied by the following fraction:
- 11 \_\_\_\_\_\_(i) The numerator shall be the average of the
- 12 consumer price index for the twelve (12) calendar months in the calendar year
- 13 immediately preceding July 1 but in no event an amount less than the
- 14 denominator; and
- 15 (ii) The denominator shall be the average of the
- 16 consumer price index for the twelve (12) calendar months in the calendar year
- 17 immediately preceding the effective date of the benefit.
- 18 (B) In no event shall the redetermined amount be less than
- 19 the amount of the benefit otherwise payable.
- 20 (b) Each July 1, the Arkansas Judicial Retirement System shall
- 21 redetermine the amount of each monthly benefit which has been payable by the
- 22 system for at least twelve (12) full calendar months. The redetermined amount
- 23 shall be payable for the following twelve (12) calendar months.
- 24 (c) This method of redetermination of the amount of retirement benefits
- 25 shall be applicable to any judge first elected after July 1, 1983.
- 26 (c) Subject to the maximum stated in subsection (d) of this section,
- 27 the redetermined amount shall be the amount of benefit payable as of the
- 28 immediately preceding July 1, increased by three percent (3%).
- 29 (d) In no event shall the redetermined amount be more than the amount
- 30 of the benefit payable as of the immediately preceding July 1 multiplied by
- 31 the following fraction:
- 32 (1) the numerator shall be the average of the consumer price index
- 33 for the twelve (12) calendar months in the calendar year immediately preceding
- 34 July 1, but in no event an amount less than the denominator; and
- 35 (2) the denominator shall be the average of the consumer price
- 36 index for the twelve (12) calendar months in the calendar year second

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1 preceding the redetermination date.
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         (e) This method of redetermination of the amount of the retirement
 3 benefits shall be applicable to any judge first elected after July 1, 1983."
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         SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature
 6 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
 7 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
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         SECTION 3. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to
10 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect
11 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
12 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this
13 act are declared to be severable.
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         SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
16 hereby repealed.
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         SECTION 5. Emergency. It is hereby found and determined by the
1 8
19 Eighty-First General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the
20 redetermination of benefits provision of the Arkansas Judicial Retirement
21 System needs clarification and that the effective administration of the system
22 will be aided by implementing these changes at the beginning of the State's
23 fiscal year. Therefore, in order to promote sound administration in State
24 government, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this act being
25 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and
26 safety, shall become effective July 1, 1997.
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
