21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSA	\S:	
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23	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-6-219 is amended to read	d as follows:	
24	"24-6-219. Benefits - Redetermination of benefits.		
25	(a) $\frac{(1)}{(1)}$ Each July 1, the State Police Retirement System shall		
26	redetermine the amount of each monthly benefit which has been payable by the		
27	system for at least twelve (12) full calendar months. The re	edetermined am	ount
28	shall be payable for the following twelve (12) calendar month	ıs.	
29	$\frac{(2)}{(b)}$ Subject to the maximum stated in subdivision (a)(3) subsection		
30	<u>c)</u> of this section, the redetermined amount shall be the amount of the		
31	benefit payable as of the immediately preceding July 1, increased by three		
32	percent (3%).		
33	(3) In no event shall the redetermined amount be less	than the amou	nt
34	f the benefit otherwise payable nor be more than the amount of the benefit		
35	otherwise payable multiplied by the following fraction: The r	umerator shal	l be
36	the average of the consumer price index for the twelve (12) of	alendar month	g in

- 1 the calendar year immediately preceding the July 1, but in no event shall it
- 2 be an amount less than the denominator, which shall be the average of the
- 3 consumer price index for the twelve (12) calendar months in the calendar year
- 4 immediately preceding the effective date of the benefit.
- 5 (c) In no event shall the redetermined amount be more than the amount
- 6 of the benefit payable as of the immediately preceding July 1 multiplied by
- 7 the following fraction:
- 8 (1) the numerator shall be the average of the consumer price index
- 9 for the twelve (12) calendar months in the calendar year immediately preceding
- 10 July 1, but in no event an amount less than the denominator; and
- 11 (2) the denominator shall be the average of the consumer price
- 12 index for the twelve (12) calendar months in the calendar year second
- 13 preceding the redetermination date.
- 14 $\frac{(b)}{(d)}$ As used in this section÷,
- 15 (1) "The amount of the benefit otherwise payable" means the monthly
- 16 amount of benefit which would be payable disregarding the provisions of this
- 17 section redetermining benefit amounts after retirement;
- 18 (2)(A) _Consumer price index_ means the Consumer Price Index for All
- 19 Urban Consumers, as determined by the United States Department of Labor and in
- 20 effect January 1, 1987.
- 21 (B) However, should the consumer price index be restructured subsequent
- 22 to 1986 in a manner materially changing its character, the board, after
- 23 receiving the advice of the actuary, shall change the application of the
- 24 consumer price index so that, as far as is practicable, the 1986 intent of the
- 25 use of the consumer price index shall be continued."

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- 27 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature
- 28 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
- 29 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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- 31 SECTION 3. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to
- 32 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect
- 33 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
- 34 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this
- 35 act are declared to be severable.

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SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
 2 hereby repealed.
         SECTION 5. Emergency. It is hereby found and determined by the
 5 Eighty-First General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the
 6 redetermination of benefits provision of the Arkansas State Police Retirement
 7 System needs clarification and that the effective administration of the system
 8 will be aided by implementing these changes at the beginning of the State's
 9 fiscal year. Therefore, in order to promote sound administration in State
10 government, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this act being
11 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and
12 safety, shall become effective July 1, 1997.
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
