15 "AN ACT FOR THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR  
16 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 1997-99 BIENNIUM."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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20 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established  
21 for the Office of the Governor for the 1997-99 biennium, the following maximum  
22 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions  
23 of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201  
24 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided,  
25 however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set  
26 out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform  
27 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
28 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
29 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
30 successor.

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24 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for  
 25 the Office of the Governor for the 1997-99 biennium, the following maximum  
 26 number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help",  
 27 payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: three (3) temporary  
 28 or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those  
 29 provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor,  
 30 or this act for the appropriate classification.

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32 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,  
 33 to the Office of the Governor, to be payable from the State Central Services  
 34 Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Office of the  
 35 Governor for the biennial period ending June 30, 1999, the following:

SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. TRANSFER PROVISIONS. Any unexpended balance of appropriation provided in this Act, excluding Regular Salaries, which remains at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998, shall be transferred forward and made available for the same purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999.

SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

1 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
2 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
3 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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5 SECTION 7. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
6 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
7 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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9 SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
10 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
11 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
12 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
13 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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15 SECTION 9. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
16 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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18 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
19 Eighty-First General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
20 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that  
21 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1997 is essential to the operation of  
22 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
23 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
24 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1997 could work irreparable harm upon the  
25 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
26 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
27 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
28 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1997.

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
