Any insurer which violates or fails to comply with the 7 provisions of this act shall pay to the Arkansas Department of Insurance a 8 penalty in the amount of four hundred dollars (\$400) for each such violation 9 or failure to comply. 10 11 SECTION 5. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 12 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 13 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 14 15 SECTION 6. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 16 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 17 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 18 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 19 act are declared to be severable. 20 21 SECTION 7.
