24	and subject to the restrictions prescribed by Arkansas concealed handgun law	
	(Ark. Code 5-73-301 et seq.) provided that the concealed handgun law of the	
26	state that issued the license is at least as restrictive as Arkansas'	
27	concealed handgun law and that the state that issued the license recognizes	
28	concealed handgun licenses issued under Arkansas Code 5-73-301 et seq.	
29	The Director of the Department of State Police shall make a determination as	
30	to which states' permits will be recognized in Arkansas and provide that list
