19	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 17-87-102(3)(B) is amended to read as follows				
20	"(B) Practice of certified <u>registered</u> nurse anesthesia means the				
21	performance for compensation of advanced nursing skills relevant to the				
22	administration of anesthetics in collaboration with the presence of and under				
23	the supervision of a licensed physician, or licensed dentist, or other person				
24	<u>lawfully</u> entitled to order anesthesia. Collaboration means a process which				
25	involves an anesthesiologist, a physician, a dentist, or other person lawfull				
26	entitled to orde	r anesthesia, working with a Certified Regis	stered Nurse		
27	Anesthetist, each contributing his or her area of expertise, consistent with				
28	his or her licensure, to the extent required by the credentialing process of
