17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKAN	ISAS:

19	SECTION 1. (a) Effective January 1, 1999, there is	hereby created	<u>in</u>
20	the Fourth Judicial District an additional circuit-chancery	y judgeship, whi	ch
21	shall have jurisdiction in law, equity, and probate.		
22	(b) The qualified electors of the Fourth Judicial Di	istrict shall el	ect
23	the additional circuit-chancery judge created herein at the	November 1998	
24	general election to take office on January 1, 1999. The ac	dditional judge	
25	shall be elected in the same manner and shall satisfy the s	same qualificati	ons
26	for holding office and shall receive the same salary, exper	nses, and other	
27	allowances as provided by law for judges of the circuit-cha	ancery courts.	The
28	judge shall serve for elected terms of four (4) years.		
29			
30	SECTION 2. The counties which comprise the Fourth Ju	udicial District	
31	shall provide the courtroom and office facilities and suppl	lies for the jud	ge
32	of the circuit-chancery judgeship created by this act, which	ch shall be paid	out
33	of the county treasuries in the same manner as other demand	ds against the	
34	counties, out of funds appropriated by the respective quoru	um courts of the	
35	counties for such purposes.

1	SECTION 3. There shall be provided for the judge of the	
2	circuit-chancery judgeship created by this act a court reporter and a trial	
3	court administrative assistant whose salaries shall be fixed and paid in the	
4	manner provided by law for court reporters and trial court administrative	
5	assistants of the circuit-chancery courts of this state.	
6		
7	SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature	
8	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code	
9	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.	
10		
11	SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to	
12	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect	
13	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without	
14	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this	
15	act are declared to be severable.

17	SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are	
18	hereby repealed.
