10	SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - <u>CARRY FORWARD. At the close of the fiscal</u>

34	it necessary that the Department of Computer Services receives additional
35	appropriations to carry out the objectives of the agency, the Director of the

1	Department of Computer Services is hereby authorized to request the approval						
2	of the Governor and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, as hereinafter						
3	provided, for transfer of the additional appropriations provided the						
4	Department by Section 4, but in no event shall the transfers exceed the

SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the 8 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such 9 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which 10 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this 11 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable. 12 13 SECTION 17. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict 14 with this Act are hereby repealed. 15 SECTION 18. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.
