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22	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the					
23	Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer, to be payable

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- SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
- 9 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 10 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

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SECTION 4. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this

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31 SECTION 6. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict 32 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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34 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. <u>It is hereby found and determined by the</u> 35 Eighty-First General Assembly that funds provided by the General Assembly for

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1 the operations of the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing
 2 Officer are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Department
 3 of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer to continue to provide
 4 essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide
 5 the necessary monies for the Department of Finance and Administration -
 6 Disbursing Officer to continue such services; and that a delay in the
 7 effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper
 8 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,
 9 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
   immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
11 force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
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
