For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 20-23-201(a) TO PROVIDE
10 THAT THE MEMBERS OF THE BOILER ADVISORY BOARD SHALL BE
11 APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR AND THAT THE DIRECTOR OF LABOR
12 SHALL BE EX OFFICIO CHAIRMAN; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

15 "TO PROVIDE THAT THE MEMBERS OF THE
16 BOILER ADVISORY BOARD SHALL BE APPOINTED
17 BY THE GOVERNOR AND THAT THE DIRECTOR OF
18 LABOR SHALL BE EX OFFICIO CHAIRMAN."

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 20-23-201(a) is amended to read as follows:

23 "(a)(1) There is created a Boiler Advisory Board.

24 (2) The board shall be appointed by the ~~chief inspector, with the~~
25 ~~consent of the Director of the Arkansas Department of Labor~~ Governor. In
26 addition to the ~~chief inspector~~ Director of Labor, who shall be ex officio
27 chairman, the Boiler Advisory Board shall consist of five (5) members.

28 (A) One (1) member of the board, who must be employed by an
29 insurance company insuring steam boilers, and who must have had issued to him
30 a certificate of competency and commission as an inspector of steam boilers,
31 shall represent insurance companies insuring steam boilers;

32 (B) A second member, who must be an owner or official of a
33 concern using at least two hundred (200) boiler horsepower and who must have
34 had ten (10) years' experience in the operation of boilers, shall represent
35 concerns using steam boilers;

36 (C) A third member, who must have had ten (10) years'

1 experience in the construction of boilers, shall represent the boiler
2 manufacturers or boilermakers;

3 (D) A fourth member, who must have had ten (10) years'
4 experience in the operation of boilers, shall represent the operating
5 engineers; and

6 (E) A fifth member, who shall be an anhydrous ammonia
7 dealer, shall represent the anhydrous ammonia industry.

8 (3) The terms of office of the five (5) members so appointed shall
9 be for five (5) years and shall commence on date of appointment and shall be
10 arranged ~~by the chief inspector~~ in such manner that the term of one (1) of
11 such members shall expire on January 14 of each year."

12

13 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
14 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
15 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the code.

16

17 SECTION 3. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to
18 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
19 other provisions or applications of the
20 act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application,
21 and to this end the provision of this act are declared to be severable.

22

23 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
24 hereby repealed.
