### For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT ANY PERSON USING A BLUE LIGHT  
10 DURING COMMISSION OF A CRIME WILL BE GUILTY OF A CLASS B  
11 FELONY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

### Subtitle

13  
14 "TO PROVIDE THAT ANY PERSON USING A BLUE  
15 LIGHT DURING COMMISSION OF A CRIME WILL  
16 BE GUILTY OF A CLASS B FELONY."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
19

20 SECTION 1. Any person who uses a blue rotating or flashing light on any  
21 vehicle while committing a crime shall be deemed guilty of a Class B felony.  
22

23 SECTION 2. The provisions of this act do not apply to law enforcement  
24 officers.  
25

26 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
27 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
28 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.  
29

30 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
31 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
32 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
33 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
34 act are declared to be severable.  
35

36 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are

1 hereby repealed.
