The disbursing officer of the 4 5 appropriations provided for herein, shall deposit all monies received by the 6 Office of Attorney General as attorney fees in the State Central Services Fund as direct revenues. 9 SECTION 22. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS.
