9 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 8-4-202(e)(2); TO AMEND THE
10 TIME FOR EMERGENCY RULEMAKING; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

13 "TO AMEND THE LAW FOR EMERGENCY
14 RULEMAKING TO PROVIDE FOR MORE THAN
15 NINETY DAYS."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 8-4-202(e)(2), concerning emergency rulemaking
20 of the Arkansas Department of Pollution Control and Ecology, is amended to
21 read as follows:

22 "(e)(2) No rule, regulation, suspension, or moratorium adopted under an
23 emergency declaration shall be effective for longer than ~~ninety (90) days~~ one
24 hundred and eighty (180) days."

26 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
27 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
28 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

30 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
31 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
32 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
33 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
34 act are declared to be severable.

36 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are

1 hereby repealed.
