12 30, 1999; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."  
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## Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND  
15 TOURISM - HISTORY COMMISSION  
16 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 1997-99 BIENNIUM."  
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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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21 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - STATE. There is hereby established for  
22 the Department of Parks and Tourism - History Commission - State for the  
23 1997-99 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose  
24 salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and  
25 Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all  
26 laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a  
27 specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt  
28 from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All  
29 persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the  
30 provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas  
31 Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Parks and Tourism - History Commission for the 1997-99 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: two (2) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - STATE. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Parks and Tourism - History Commission, to be payable from the Parks and Tourism Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the Department of Parks and Tourism - History Commission - State for the biennial period ending June 30, 1999, the following:

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8 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS - CASH. There is hereby appropriated, to the

9 Department of Parks and Tourism - History Commission, to be payable from cash

10 funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Department of Parks and

11 Tourism - History Commission, for operating expenses of the Department of

12 Parks and Tourism - History Commission - Cash for the biennial period ending

13 June 30, 1999, the following:

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25 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

26 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

27 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

28 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and

29 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

30 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control

31 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the

32 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be

33 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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35 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

1 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
2 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
3 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
4 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
5 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
6 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
7 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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9 SECTION 7. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
10 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
11 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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13 SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
14 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
15 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
16 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
17 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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19 SECTION 9. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
20 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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22 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
23 Eighty-First General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
24 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that  
25 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1997 is essential to the operation of  
26 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
27 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
28 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1997 could work irreparable harm upon the  
29 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
30 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
31 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
32 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1997.
