# A Bill

SENATE BILL 3

## For An Act To Be Entitled

7 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
8 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE STATE MILITARY DEPARTMENT  
9 NATIONAL GUARD MUSEUM FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE  
10 30, 1999; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

13 "AN ACT FOR THE STATE MILITARY  
14 DEPARTMENT - NATIONAL GUARD MUSEUM  
15 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 1997-99 BIENNIUM."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - ARKANSAS NATIONAL GUARD MUSEUM. There is  
20 hereby established for the State Military Department - Arkansas National Guard  
21 Museum for the 1997-99 biennium, the following maximum number of regular  
22 employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform  
23 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its  
24 successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any  
25 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in  
26 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification  
27 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are  
28 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and  
29 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS - ARKANSAS NATIONAL GUARD MUSEUM. There is hereby appropriated, to the State Military Department, to be payable from the State General Services Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas National Guard Museum for the biennial period ending June 30, 1999, the following:

SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

1 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
2 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
3 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

5 SECTION 5. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
6 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
7 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

9 SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
10 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
11 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
12 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
13 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

15 SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
16 with this Act are hereby repealed.

17

18 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
19 Eighty-First General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
20 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that  
21 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1997, is essential to the operation  
22 of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that  
23 in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the  
24 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1997 could work irreparable  
25 harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
26 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
27 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
28 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1997.
