Arkansas Code 8 12-9-403 is amended to read as follows: 2.1 "12-9-403. Appointment and training. 2.2 (a) No person shall be appointed as a police traffic radar operator or 2.3 24 police traffic radar instructor until the minimum standards for training 25 requirements have been completed. 26 (b) All police traffic radar operators shall have one (1) year from 27 March 22, 1983, to have completed the required training or to have previously 28 met the training requirements or the training equivalent as determined by the 29 Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training. 30 (c) The training requirements for police traffic radar operators or 31 police traffic radar instructors shall be established by the commission. 32 (d) The commission may issue a certificate evidencing satisfactory 33 completion of the requirements of this subchapter when evidence is submitted 34 by the law enforcement agency director, chief, or sheriff that the police 35 traffic radar operator has met the training requirements.

(e) Nothing herein shall be construed to preclude any law enforcement

- 1 agency from establishing qualifications and standards for appointing and
- 2 training of police traffic radar operators and police traffic radar
- 3 instructors that exceed those set by this subchapter or by the commission.
- 4 (f) Any police traffic radar operator or police traffic radar
- 5 instructor failing to meet the training requirements as set forth in this
- 6 subchapter shall lose his authority to operate traffic radar for enforcement
- 7 purposes.
- 8 (g) An officer must have completed the basic police training course
- 9 required for officer certification before being eligible to enroll and
- 10 complete the traffic radar course as prescribed by the commission the
- 11 commission required training for officer certification before being eligible
- 12 for certification as a police traffic radar operator.
- 13 (h) Only full-time, part-time I and part-time II officers, as defined
- 14 by commission regulation, will be eligible for certification as a police
- 15 traffic radar operator."

- 17 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature
- 18 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
- 19 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

20

- 21 SECTION 3. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to
- 22 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect
- 23 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
- 24 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this
- 25 act are declared to be severable.

- 27 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
- 28 hereby repealed.
