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28	SECTION 1. $(a)(1)$ The Director of the General Educat	ion Division o	<u>, f</u>
29	the Arkansas Department of Education shall establish a task	force to selec	<u>:t</u>
30	instructional resource materials appropriate for teaching A	rican-American	Ļ
31	history in all grade clusters in kindergarten through grade twelve (K-12) in

33	(2) Such task force shall be known as the Black	History Task	
34	Force, consisting of seven (7) members appointed by the chairman of the Black		
35	History Advisory Committee of the Arkansas History Commission, and shall		
36	further advise the director in the selection of:		

1 (A) Training components for using the instructional 2 resource materials; and 3 (B) Training components for assisting teachers and administrators in developing a greater awareness of ethnic and racial 5 differences, improving interpersonal skills, and enhancing racial harmony. 6 (b)(1) The director shall ensure that selection of instructional resource materials and training components is completed during the 1997-98 8 school year and that all materials are provided to the school districts and 9 all training concluded by no later than August 1, 1999. 10 (2) All training shall be delivered through the statewide system 11 of education service cooperatives and the three (3) Pulaski County school 12 districts. (c) The director shall report annually to the Black History Advisory 13 14 Committee of the Arkansas History Commission regarding implementation of this 15 act. 16 (d) The Department of Education is authorized to promulgate regulations to carry out the provisions of this act and shall distribute to each local school district a copy of such regulations. 19 (e) Dissemination of materials and all training required under this act shall be contingent upon the availability of funds appropriated for such purposes. 22 23 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 24 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 25 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 26 2.7 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 28 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 29 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 30 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 31 act are declared to be severable. 32
