23	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 11-10-703(a)(3) is amended to read as follows
26	"(3) However, regular benefit payments shall not be charged to the
27	separate account of any employer if the employer provides the director with
28	notices regarding separation from work as are required by regulations of the
29	director if the director finds that:
30	(A) The claimant voluntarily left the employer without good caus
31	connected with the work; or
32	(B) The claimant was discharged by the employer for misconduct
33	connected with the work- ; or
34	(C) If the employee was terminated, voluntarily or involuntarily
35	within the first ninety (90) days of employment.
