15		SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. EXTRA HELP	_	STATE. There	is	hereby		
16	autho	rized, for the Department of Education - E	duc	ational Telev	risio	n Division		
17	for the 1997-99 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or							
18	temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds							
19	appropriated herein for such purposes: Ten (10) temporary or part-time							
20	employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the							
21	1 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, for the							
22	2 appropriate classification. Many of these positions are related to specific							
23	3 projects, and those positions so related are specifically exempt from							
24	4 limitations of hours, either by act or regulation.

26	SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. EXTRA HELP - CASH. There is hereby							
27	authorized, for the Department of Education - Educational Television Division							
28	for the 1997-99 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or							
29	temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds							
30	appropriated herein for such purposes: Thirty one (31) temporary or part-time							
31	employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the							
32	Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, for the							
33	appropriate classification. Many of these positions are related to specific							
34	projects, and those positions so related are specifically exempt from							
35	limitations of hours, either by act or regulation.							

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2 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State 3 shall establish upon request for the Department of Education - Educational 4 Television Division a special appropriation line item to be used in the 5 acquisition of promotional items. When the Department of Education -6 Educational Television Division wishes to transfer monies from its operating expenses appropriation to the promotional items line, the AETN Commission shall approve the request and forward it to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the 9 State for processing. 10 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 11 12 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 13 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 14 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 15 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 16 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control 17 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the 18 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 19 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 20 21 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 22 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 23 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which 24 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 25 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 26 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 27 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 28 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 29 30 SECTION 9. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent 31 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas 32 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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34 SECTION 10. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the 35 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such

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2 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
 3 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.
         SECTION 11. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
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 6 with this Act are hereby repealed.
         SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
9 Eighty-First General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
10 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
11 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1997 is essential to the operation of
12 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
13 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
14 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1997 could work irreparable harm upon the
15 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
16 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
17 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
18 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1997.
