BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
    SECTION 1. (a) There is established a Crowleys Ridge Trail Commission
to consist of fifteen (15) members from the Crowleys Ridge area to be
appointed as follows:
    (1) Five (5) members shall be appointed by the Governor;
    (2) Five (5) members shall be appointed by the President Pro Tem
of the Senate; and
(3) Five (5) members shall be appointed by the Speaker of the
House.
    (b) The initial members of the commission shall draw lots so that five
(5) serve a one-year term; five (5) serve a two-year term; and five (5) serve
a three-year term. Successor members shall serve three (3) year terms except
that persons appointed to fill vacancies resulting in an unexpired term shall
serve for the remainder of that unexpired term.
    (c) Upon recommendation of the commission, made after notice and
hearing, the Governor may remove any member of the commission for
incompetence, neglect of duty or malfeasance in office.
    (d) Any vacancy on the commission shall be filled in the same manner
the appointment was made under subsection (a).
    (e) The Governor shall call the first commission meeting and designate

a member to preside at that meeting. The commission shall elect annually from
its membership a chairperson, vice-chairperson and a secretary. The
commission shall meet as frequently as it deems necessary, at such times and
places as the commission designates. Additional meetings may be held upon
call of the chairperson or upon written request of eight (8) members of the
commission.
    (f) Eight (8) members of the commission shall constitute a quorum.
    (g) The members of the commission shall serve without compensation.
    SECTION 2. The Crowleys Ridge Trail Commission shall:
    (1) investigate the possibility of establishing scenic hiking, biking,

and walking trails along the length of Crowleys Ridge from Cape Girardeau,
Missouri to Helena, Arkansas;
(2) study the feasibility of financing the establishment of scenic
hiking, biking, and walking trails along Crowleys Ridge with resources from
foundations, other private financial sources, federal or state grants, or
other funding;
(3) develop and coordinate efforts to encourage gifts or donations to
the commission to be used to support the work of the commission and to be used
for the establishment of scenic trails along Crowleys Ridge;
(4) study the possibility of using volunteers, such as Ameri-Corps
volunteers, recipients of Transitional Employment Assistance, and others to
construct the trails; and
(5) report its findings to the State Parks and Tourism Department, the
General Assembly, and the Governor by January 15, 1999.
SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
