23	(a) Whenever an active or retired police officer shall	die or be	
24	killed, the board of trustees shall appropriate from the fund	l a sum of not	
25	less than one hundred dollars (\$100) nor more than two thousa	end dollars	
26	(\$2,000) four thousand dollars $($4,000)$ to pay the funeral expenses of the		
27	decedent.		
28	(b) Each board of trustees shall adopt a policy establ	ishing the am	ount
29	to be paid for funeral expenses pursuant to this section, and	the amount s	hall
30	be awarded uniformly to all eligible persons.		
31	(c) The board of trustees may change the amount of fur	eral expenses	
32	payable under this section, but, in that instance, the amount shall be		
33	uniformly distributed likewise.		
34	(d) The effective date of the 1983 amendment to this s	section shall	be
35	retroactive to June 17, 1981."
