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22	SECTION 1. (a)	Any person licensed to practice law, n	medicine, or

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1	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
2	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
3	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
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5	SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
6	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
7	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
8	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
9	act are declared to be severable.
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11	SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
12	hereby repealed.
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14	SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is found and determined by the General
15	Assembly of the State of Arkansas that, in light of the vast devastation
16	caused by the recent tornadoes which crossed the state of Arkansas, many
17	Arkansas citizens are in urgent need of legal and medical assistance and many
18	legal and medical professionals stand ready, willing, and able to assist these
19	citizens free of charge, and to offer some immunity to these professionals
20	will enhance their ability to render this assistance. Therefore an emergency
21	is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the
22	preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective on
23	the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor
24	vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the
25	period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is
26	vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective
27	on the date the last house overrides the veto.
