20	BE IT ENACTED BY	THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKAN	SAS:

22	SECTION 1. (a) After the repeal of Arkansas Code 6 24-8-303 providing				
23	for the levy of court costs to fund the municipal court judges and clerks				
24	retirement fund, a municipality having provided for retirement benefits for				
25	municipal court judges and court clerks in accordance with Subchapter 3 of				
26	Title 24, Chapter 8 of the Arkansas Code of 1987, Annotated, (Act 432 of 1973,				
27	as amended) shal	al continue to provide funds for the retirem	ent benefits in	<u>1</u>	
28	that subchapter in accordance with the funding provisions of Section 11 of Act				
29	1256 of 1995, as long as those provisions allow. Those funds and any				
30	additional funds provided for by this act, if levied by the municipality,				
31	shall be to provide for the retirement benefits in that subchapter.				
32	(b) The funds for the municipal court judge and clerk retirement fund				
33	provided for by Section 11 of Act 1256 of 1995 and any additional funds for				
34	municipal court judge and court clerk retirement benefits provided for by this				
35	act, if levied by the municipality, shall be paid to the city treasurer, who				
36	shall place them	n into an account as provided for in Subchap	ter 3 of Title	24.

- 3 SECTION 2. (a) In addition to the funds for the municipal court judge
- 4 and clerk retirement fund provided for by Section 11 of Act 1256 of 1995, if
- 5 the municipal judges retirement board of trustees determines by actuarial
- 6 valuation that the account will not be able to meet its financial objective of
- 7 paying for its current and any projected retirement benefits, a municipality
- 8 may, beginning January 1, 1998, also add to the account, by city ordinance,
- 9 any, or all, of the following moneys:
- 10 (1) up to five percent (5%) of all fines and forfeitures collected by
- 11 the municipal court or by the city for violations of municipal ordinances or
- 12 state laws; and
- 13 (2) An annual contribution from the city's general fund in an amount
- 14 recommended by actuarial valuation to meet its projected financial obligation.
- 15 (3) a one-time or occasional lump-sum payments from the city's general
- 16 fund in an amount determined by the city governing body, along with any
- 17 payments or contributions from the county when the city and county share
- 18 expenses and costs of a county-wide court.

- 20 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature
- 21 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
- 22 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

- 24 SECTION 4. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to
- 25 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect
- 26 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
- 27 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this
- 28 act are declared to be severable.

- 30 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
- 31 hereby repealed.

- 33 SECTION 6. Emergency. It is hereby found and determined by the
- 34 Eighty-First General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that Act 1256 of 1995
- 35 repealed Arkansas Code & 24-8-303 and effectively capped the court costs
- 36 funding mechanism used to fund the retirement benefits for municipal court

1	judges and court clerks; that the use of court costs alone does not provide an
2	adequate source of funding for the municipal judges' and court clerks'
3	retirement benefits; that retirement benefits costs are continuing to rise
4	faster than the current funding sources; and that it is sound financial
5	planning and necessary to prevent financial disaster to Arkansas cities' to
6	provide a broader financial base through additional sources of funding for
7	these municipal retirement benefits. Therefore, in order to promote a sound
8	financial plan and prevent financial disaster for Arkansas' cities, an
9	emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this act being necessary for the
10	immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, shall be in
11	full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
