19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. The General Assembly hereby finds that during the 1995
22 Legislative Session the Legislature appropriated funds for the 1996-97 school
23 year to provide fiscal crisis relief funding to school districts who suffered
24 an unanticipated adverse impact or an unexpected fiscal crisis due to a change
25 in the states school funding formula. The 1996-97 school year is two-thirds
26 (2/3) over, and no fiscal crisis relief funds have been distributed for the
27 current school year. School districts suffering due to an unanticipated
28 adverse impact or unexpected fiscal crisis have not received sufficient funds
29 to operate school for the 1996-97 school year. Therefore, the Legislature
30 must act to require an immediate disbursement.

32 SECTION 2. The Arkansas Department of Education and the State Board of
33 Education shall distribute such fiscal crisis funds to the following school
34 districts for fiscal crisis relief because of a loss of maintenance and
35 operation revenues and in accordance with the Department's most recent
36 printout as follows:

29 SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
 30 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
 31 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

33 SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application
 34 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall
 35 not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given
 36 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the

1 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

3 SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act
4 are hereby repealed.

5

6 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY. It is found and determined by the General
7 Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the absence of any fiscal crisis relief
8 funding for the 1996-97 school year is causing severe harm to those school
9 districts the funding was designed to assist. Those school districts have
10 relied on the General Assemblys commitment to such funding and are currently
11 experiencing adverse impacts due to the failure to distribute such funds.
12 Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately
13 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall
14 become effective on the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is
15 neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the
16 expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill.
17 If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall
18 become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto.
