23	SECTION 1. Arkansas code 6 12-8-209 is amended by inser-	ting an	
24	additional subsection at the end thereof to read as follows:		
25	"(d) All officers, patrolmen and employees who are oth	erwise entitl	ed
26	to the receipt of a special travel allowance or uniform allow	ance in	
27	accordance with this statute, shall become ineligible for sai	d allowances	when
28	they have been absent on sick leave for more than twenty (20)	consecutive	
29	working days; or, at any time that said employee has establish	hed a substan	tial
30	abuse of the departments sick leave policy.		
31	(1) The Director of the Arkansas State Police sh	all have the	
32	authority to restore the receipt of the special uniform and/o	r travel	
33	allowance, upon information and belief that the entitled empl	oyee is not	
34	presently abusing the sick leave process, and can not be assi	gned to a	
35	temporary light duty position due to the egregious nature of	the illness.

         SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
 5 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
 6 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

         SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
 9 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
10 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
11 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
12 act are declared to be severable.
