- 1 to assault or abuse any $\underline{\text{student or}}$ teacher, principal, superintendent, or
- 2 other employee of a school system;
- 3 (B) Possession by students of any firearm or other weapon

- 6 (C) Using, offering for sale, or selling beer, alcoholic

- 16 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
- 17 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
- 18 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

- 20 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
- 21 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
- 22 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
- 23 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
- 24 act are declared to be severable.

- SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
- 27 hereby repealed.
