1 (2) The television screen shall contain the words "Legal Notice" in a 2 conspicuous manner and any radio notice shall also state the same. 3 (3) The legal notice shall be televised on cable television or 4 broadcast on commercial radio or commercial television the same number of 5 times and for the same period of time as required of the notice through 6 publication in a newspaper. (4) The broadcast media shall comply with all legal publication 7 8 requirements set forth in this act, which currently exist and which apply to 9 the print media including, but not limited to, providing certification that 10 the television or radio broadcast occurred in compliance with Arkansas law. 11 12 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 13 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 14 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 15 16 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 17 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 18 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 19 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 20 act are declared to be severable. 21 SECTION 4.
