(b) The premium on such policy or policies shall be paid annually out 8 9 of funds in the Public School Fund that are set aside for distribution to the 10 various school districts under Acts 1977, No. 384 [repealed].

17 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 18 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 19 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 22 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 23 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 24 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 25 act are declared to be severable.
