18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:	
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20	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 26, Chapter 51, Subchapter 4 is amended	l
21	to add a new section to read as follows:	
22	"26-51-447. Deductions - Tuition to Post-Secondary Educational	
23	Institutions.	
24	(a) In computing net income for the purposes of the Arkansas Income Ta	ιX
25	Act, as amended, $^{\dagger}26-51-101$ et seq., there shall be allowed as a deduction in	
26	addition to all other deductions allowed by law for a portion of the amount	
27	paid by the taxpayer as tuition for the taxpayer, the taxpayers spouse or	
28	dependent to attend a post-secondary educational institution. The deduction	
29	shall be equal to fifty percent (50%) of the lesser of either the amount of	
30	tuition paid or the weighted average tuition for post-secondary educational	
31	institutions of the same classification.	
32	(b) On or before November 30, 1998 of each year thereafter, the	
33	director shall determine the weighted average tuition of post-secondary	
34	institutions of each of the following classifications:	
35	(1) Four-year institutions of higher education;	
36	(2) Two-year institutions of higher education; and	

1	(3) Technical institutes.
2	(c)(1) For the purpose of this section, weighted average tuition means
3	the tuition cost resulting from the following calculation:
4	(A) Add the products of the annual tuition at each state-
5	supported post-secondary institution of the same classification multiplied by
6	that institution's total number of fiscal-year-equated students; and
7	(B) Divide the gross total of the product from subdivision
8	(d)(1) of this section by the total number of fiscal-year-equated students
9	attending each state-supported post-secondary institution of the same
10	classification.
11	(2) For four-year institutions of higher education only
12	undergraduate tuition and undergraduate students shall be used in calculating
13	weighted average tuition."
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15	SECTION 2. This act shall be effective for tax years beginning on or
16	after January 1, 1998.
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18	SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
19	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
20	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
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22	SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
23	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
24	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
25	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
26	act are declared to be severable.
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28	SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
29	hereby repealed.
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
