11 ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER WHICH SHALL BE
12 SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED
13 BY ACT 1099 OF 1995; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
23

24 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the
25 Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer, to be payable
26 from the State Central Services Fund, for personal services of the University
27 of Arkansas - Medical Sciences - Child Abuse/Rape/Domestic Violence Section
28 which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in
29 Section 9 of Act 1099 of 1995, the following:

35 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the
36 Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer, to be payable

1 from the State Central Services Fund, for contractual services in the delivery
 2 of child welfare services by the University of Arkansas Medical Sciences Child
 3 Abuse/Rape/Domestic Violence Section which shall be supplemental and in
 4 addition to those funds appropriated in Section 11 of Act 1099 of 1995, the
 5 following:

11 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
 12 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
 13 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
 14 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
 15 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 16 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
 17 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
 18 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 19 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

20

21 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 22 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 23 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
 24 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
 25 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
 26 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
 27 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
 28 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

29

30 SECTION 5. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
 31 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
 32 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

33

34 SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
 35 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such

1 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
2 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
3 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

5 SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
6 with this Act are hereby repealed.

7

8 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
9 Eighty-First General Assembly that funds provided by the General Assembly for
10 the operations of the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing
11 Officer are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Department
12 of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer to continue to provide
13 essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide
14 the necessary monies for the Department of Finance and Administration -
15 Disbursing Officer to continue such services; and that a delay in the
16 effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper
17 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,
18 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
19 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
20 force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
