In counties having two (2) judicial districts, 15 the jurisdiction shall be limited to the district in which the court is 16 situated." 17 1 8 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 19 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 20 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 21 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 2.2 23 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 24 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 25 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 26 act are declared to be severable. 27 SECTION 4.
