9 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED [§] 11-9-810(b) TO
10 PROVIDE FOR THE REPORTING OF ADDITIONAL PAYMENTS IN
11 WORKERS' COMPENSATION CASES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
19

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated [§] 11-9-810(b) is amended to read as
21 follows:

22 "(b)(1) Within thirty (30) days after the final payment of compensation
23 has been made, the employer shall send to the commission a notice, in
24 accordance with a form prescribed by the commission. This form shall state
25 that the final payment has been made, the total amount of compensation paid,
26 the name of the employee and of any other person to whom compensation has been
27 paid, the date of the injury or death, and the person to whom compensation has
28 been paid. In the event that additional payments, including fees to attorneys
29 for any party, are made after the form is filed with the commission, such
30 payments shall be reported to the commission, in accordance with a form
31 prescribed by commission, within thirty (30) days of the payment.
32

33 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
34 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
35 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
36

1 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
2 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
3 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
4 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
5 act are declared to be severable.

6

7 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
8 hereby repealed.
