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1 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code $^{\circ}$ 8-7-215 is amended to read as follows: 2 "8-7-215 Permits - Requirement. (a) No person shall construct, substantially alter, or operate any 4 hazardous waste treatment or disposal facility or site, nor shall any person 5 store, transport, treat, or dispose of any hazardous waste without first 6 obtaining a permit from the department for the facility, site, or activity. (b) Persons who construct, substantially alter, or operate a facility 8 which generates hazardous wastes shall be subject to the reporting 9 requirements of this subchapter but shall not be required to obtain a permit 10 under this subchapter unless such person also stores, transports, treats, or 11 disposes of hazardous wastes." 12 13 SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 14 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 15 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 16 17 SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 18 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 19 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 20 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 21 act are declared to be severable. 22 SECTION 6.
