15	SECTION 2. <u>FUNDING TRANSFER.</u>	Immediately upon the effective date of this Act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State		
16	shall transfer on his books and those of the State Treasur	rer the sum of six million (\$6,000,000) from the Economic Development of Arkansas		
17	Fund to the Disaster Assistance Fund to provide funds for	or the appropriation provided herein.		
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19	SECTION 3. Upon a State declaration of disaster as defined in A.C.A.812-75-103(2), the Quorum Court or a local			
20	governmental entity of the counties named in Section 1 of this act may request of the Director of the State Office of Emergency Services a			
21	disbursement of the funds appropriated by this Act. Upon certification by the Director of the State Office of Emergency Services that the request			
22	is consistent with the provisions of the "Arkansas Emergency Services Act of 1973," the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State may approve			
23	disbursement of the funds appropriated in this Act for the	purpose of responding to and mitigating the effects of such disaster. Funds		
24	appropriated in this Act are to supplement county and local expenses which are not reimbursable under Federal disaster recovery programs, but for

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28	SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH C	OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this Act shall be limited to the		
29	appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State			
30	Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and			
31	Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department

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34	SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTEN	T. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority

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5	SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of				
6	1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.				
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8	SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held				
9	invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or				
10	application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.				
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12	SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.				
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14	SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. <u>It is hereby found and determined by the Eighty-First General Assembly that funds</u>				
15	provided by the General Assembly for the operations of the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer are, due to unforeseen				
16	circumstances, insufficient for the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer to continue to provide essential governmental				
17	services; that the provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer				
18	to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and				
19	provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate				
20	preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
