17	SECTION 1. Section 1 of Act 103 of 1	997 is hereby amended to read as
18	follows:	
19	"SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS. There	is hereby appropriated, to the Soil
20	and Water Conservation Commission, to be p	ayable from the Red River Waterways
21	Project Trust Fund, for expenses of a navi	gation feasibility study in
22	conjunction with the Corps of Engineers or	a cost sharing basis; the purchase
23	of mitigation lands; and for acquisition of	f right-of-way and relocation of
24	utilities for a levy rehabilitation projec	t for the Red River,
25	the sum of	\$3,333,874."

27	SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LA	WS. Disbursement of funds
28	authorized by this Act shall be limited to	the appropriation for such agency
29	and funds made available by law for the su	pport of such appropriations; and
30	the restrictions of the State Purchasing I	aw, the General Accounting and
31	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stak	ilization Law, the Regular Salary
32	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their	successors, and other fiscal control
33	laws of this State, where applicable, and	regulations promulgated by the
34	Department of Finance and Administration,	as authorized by law, shall be
35	strictly complied with in disbursement of	said funds.

1 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

- 2 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
- 3 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
- 4 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
- 5 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
- 6 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
- 7 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
- 8 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

- 10 SECTION 4. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
- 11 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
- 12 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

- 14 SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
- 15 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
- 16 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
- 17 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
- 18 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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- 20 SECTION 6. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
- 21 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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- 23 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
- 24 Eighty-First General Assembly that various studies being conducted by the
- 25 federal government regarding the use of the Red River are nearing completion;
- 26 that further studies and projects on the Red River will require state
- 27 participation; and that the provisions of this Act will provide the necessary
- 28 state resources for such projects. Therefore an emergency is declared to
- 29 exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the
- 30 public peace, health and safety shall become effective on the date of its
- 31 approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the
- 32 Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time
- 33 during which the governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the
- 34 Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the
- 35 last house overrides the veto.
