SENATE BILL 647

For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT TO REQUIRE LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO ADOPT WRITTEN
10 POLICIES SPECIFYING REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENT PARTICIPATION
11 IN EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

14 "TO REQUIRE LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO
15 ADOPT WRITTEN POLICIES SPECIFYING
16 REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENT PARTICIPATION
17 IN EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20
21 SECTION 1. (a) Each local school district shall adopt a written policy
22 specifying the requirements students must meet to be eligible to participate
23 in extracurricular activities and shall file such policy with the Department
24 of Education.

25 (b) Such written policy shall include requirements that a student:

26 (1) Pass four (4) full-credit subjects each semester, or the
27 equivalent grading period; and

28 (2) Make satisfactory progress, as determined by the district,
29 toward graduation.

30
31 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
32 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
33 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

34
35 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
36 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect

1 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
2 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
3 act are declared to be severable.

5 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
6 hereby repealed.
