- 27 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
- 28 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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- 30 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
- 31 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
- 32 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
- 33 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
- 34 act are declared to be severable.

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36 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are

1 hereby repealed. 2 3 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is found and determined by the General 4 Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the President Pro Tempore of the Senate 5 and the Speaker of the House should each make an appointment to the Joint 6 Budget Committee; and that this act shall go into effect immediately in order 7 to change the membership of the Joint Budget Committee prior to the 8 adjournment of this regular session. Therefore, an emergency is declared to 9 exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the 10 public peace, health and safety shall become effective on the date of its 11 approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the 12 Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time 13 during which the Governor may veto the bill.
