1 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to be payable

- 2 from the Constitutional Officers Fund, for salaries of the various
- 3 Constitutional Officers which shall be supplemental and in addition to those

- 11 SECTION 3. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
- 12 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
- 13 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

- 15 SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application
- 16 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall
- 17 not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given
- 18 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
- 19 provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

- 21 SECTION 5. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
- 22 this Act are hereby repealed.

- 24 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
- 25 Eighty-first General Assembly, that Amendment 70 of the Constitution of
- 26 Arkansas provides that salaries of the Executive and Legislative Department
- 27 officials may be increased annually by an amount not to exceed the average
- 28 percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers or its
- 29 successor, as published by the United States Department of Labor, for the two
- 30 years immediately preceding the year of the salary appropriation; that this
- 31 act establishes the proper salaries for the Executive and Legislative
- 32 Departments; that the delay in the effective date of this act could work
- 33 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential
- 34 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist
- 35 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
- 36 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July
