21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated $^{\circ}$ 6-17-1503 is amended to read as
22	follows:
23	"6-17-1503. Construction.
24	This subchapter is not a teacher tenure law in that it does not confer
25	lifetime appointment nor prevent discharge of teachers for any cause which is
26	not arbitrary, capricious, or discriminatory. A nonrenewal, termination,
27	suspension, or other disciplinary action by a school district shall be void
28	unless the school district strictly complies with all provisions of this
29	subchapter and the school district's applicable personnel policies."

31	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Annotated \degree 6-17-1510(b) is amended to read as
32	follows:
33	"(b) Any certified teacher who has been employed continuously by the
34	school district three (3) or more years or who may have achieved
35	nonprobationary status pursuant to \degree 6-17-1502 may <u>only</u> be terminated or the
36	board may refuse to renew the contract of the teacher for any cause which is

1 not arbitrary, capricious, or discriminatory or for violating the reasonable 2 rules and regulations promulgated by the board incompetence, conduct which 3 interferes substantially with the continued performance of the teacher's 4 duties, substantial noncompliance with school rules, gross insubordination, 5 willful neglect of duty, or other just cause. Upon completion of such hearing, 6 the board, within ten (10) days after the holding of the hearing, shall: 7 (1) Uphold the recommendation of the superintendent to terminate 8 or not renew the teacher contract; or 9 (2) Reject or modify the superintendent's recommendation to 10 terminate or not renew the contract of the teacher; or 11 (3) Vote to continue the contract of such teacher under such 12 restrictions, limitations, or assurances as the board may deem to be in the 13 best interest of the school district. The decision shall be reached by the 14 board within ten (10) days from the date of the hearing, and a copy shall be 15 furnished in writing to the teacher involved, either by personally delivering 16 it to the teacher or by addressing it to the teacher's last known address by 17 registered or certified mail." 18 19 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 20 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 21 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 22 23 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 24 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 25 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 26 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 27 act are declared to be severable. 2.8
