- 7 (3) "Qualified contractor" means a contractor which provides
- 8 health insurance and pension or retirement benefits for its employees and
- 9 employs fifty percent (50%) of its employees from the county in which the
- 10 contract is to be performed.

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- 12 SECTION 3. The provisions of this act are effective for taxable years
- 13 beginning on and after January 1, 1998.

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- 15 SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
- 16 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
- 17 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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- 19 SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
- 20 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
- 21 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
- 22 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
- 23 act are declared to be severable.

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- 25 SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
- 26 hereby repealed.

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
