9 "AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE SALARY AND EXPENSE ALLOWANCES FOR
10 THE DEPUTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEYS OF CRAIGHEAD COUNTY; AND
11 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

14 "TO ESTABLISH THE SALARY AND EXPENSE
15 ALLOWANCES FOR THE DEPUTY PROSECUTING
16 ATTORNEYS OF CRAIGHEAD COUNTY"

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
19

20 SECTION 1. The prosecuting attorney of the Second Judicial District may
21 appoint one or more deputy prosecuting attorneys and staff personnel as
22 follows for the Western and Eastern District of Craighead County, Arkansas, at
23 salaries as set and appropriated by the Quorum Court of Craighead County up to
24 the maximum salary amounts authorized as follows:

<u>Position</u>	<u>Salary</u>
<u>Chief Deputy</u>	<u>\$70,000</u>
<u>Two Assistant Deputies</u>	<u>\$40,000 each</u>
<u>One Eastern District Deputy</u>	<u>\$20,000</u>
<u>One Secretary/Receptionist</u>	<u>\$20,000</u>
<u>One Case Coordinator</u>	<u>\$25,000</u>
<u>One Investigator/Process Server</u>	<u>\$25,000</u>

32 It should be the responsibility of Craighead County, Arkansas, to pay
33 the salaries of each of the persons so appointed by the prosecuting attorney
34 of the Second Judicial District, together with any and all fringe benefits
35 otherwise available to employees of Craighead County, Arkansas, together with
36 an expense allowance as set and appropriated by the Quorum Court of Craighead

1 County up to a maximum amount of twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000) per
2 annum. Provided, that Craighead County shall pay a combined amount for
3 salaries and expenses for all deputies and staff personnel of not less than
4 one hundred eighty thousand dollars (\$180,000), and not more than two hundred
5 thirty-five thousand dollars (\$235,000) per annum. Nothing in this act shall
6 prevent payment of additional salaries and expenses of the deputy prosecuting
7 attorney of Craighead County, Arkansas, in excess of the amounts indicated
8 above from the Prosecuting Attorney Hot Check Fund established in said county,
9 subject to the approval of the Craighead County Quorum Court.

10

11 SECTION 2. This act shall be effective on and after January 1, 1998.

12

13 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
14 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
15 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

16

17 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
18 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
19 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
20 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
21 act are declared to be severable.

23 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
24 hereby repealed.
