18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 8-6-724 is amended to read as follows:
21 "8-6-724. Regional standards.

22 Regional solid waste management boards may adopt more restrictive
23 standards for the location, design, construction, and maintenance of solid
24 waste disposal sites and facilities than the state or federal governments,
25 ~~provided such standards are based upon generally accepted scientific knowledge~~
26 ~~or engineering practices and are consistent with the purposes of this~~
27 ~~subchapter.~~ provided the board states in writing the scientific basis and
28 legitimate purpose for the more restrictive standards."

29
30 SECTION 2. The provisions of this act shall be retroactive in
31 application and thereby apply to permits in existence on the effective date of
32 this act as well as permits granted hereafter.

33
34 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
35 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
36 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
