10 POPULATION OF 100,000 OR MORE TO CREATE MUNICIPAL
11 MANAGEMENT DISTRICTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENHANCING THE
12 ECONOMIC HEALTH AND VITALITY OF THE AREAS; AND FOR OTHER
13 PURPOSES."

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24
25 SECTION 1. Cities of the First Class with a population of one hundred
26 thousand (100,000) or more may enact by ordinance, a process to create a
27 Municipal Management District to manage, develop, construct and maintain
28 public works and enhancement projects in areas of municipalities.

29
30 SECTION 2. Before a district can be created, a petition must be
31 submitted to the governing body of the municipality that includes:

32 (1) a resolution to the governing body in support of the creation of
33 the district and signed by at least ninety (90) percent of the property owners
34 within the district representing at least ninety percent (90%) of the
35 appraised property value within the district and at least ninety percent (90%)
36 of the privately held land area within the district;

- 1 (2) the boundaries of the proposed district;
- 2 (3) the specific purposes for which the district will be created;
- 3 (4) the general nature of the work, projects or services proposed to be
- 4 *provided*;
- 5
- 6 (5) the method of establishing assessments for the district;
- 7 (6) a project cost estimate which shall not exceed two million dollars
- 8 (\$2,000,000); and
- 9 (7) a budget for operating and paying for improvements.

10

11 SECTION 3. The Municipal Management District will be limited to a
12 maximum of one (1) square mile.

13

14 SECTION 4. The mayor will appoint two (2) members of the governing
15 authority and three (3) residents or owners of property in the district to
16 serve on the Municipal Management District Commission. No commission member
17 shall receive compensation. The commission may retain legal council and staff
18 assistance may be provided by the municipality. Terms of the commissioners
19 will be decided by local ordinance not to exceed five (5) years.
20 Upon termination of the district, the municipality shall accept maintenance
21 responsibility for the improvements. The life of the district shall not
22 exceed ten (10) years at which time all improvements, debts, and charges will
23 be paid in full.

24

25 SECTION 5. Municipal Management Districts may establish and maintain
26 reasonable and nondiscriminatory rates, fares, tolls, charges, assessments,
27 rents or other fees or compensation for the use of the improvements
28 constructed, operated or maintained by the district. The district shall be
29 audited by a Certified Public Accountant each year with the audit findings
30 being published in a daily newspaper with circulation including the district.

31

32 SECTION 6. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
33 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
34 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

35

36 SECTION 7. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to

1 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
2 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
3 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
4 act are declared to be severable.

5

6 SECTION 8. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
7 hereby repealed.
