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21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 20-77-108 is amended to read as follows:
24	"20-77-108. Furnishing of annual audit by nonprofit Medicaid
25	providers.
26	(a) Every nonprofit corporation, except those licensed under
27	20-9-201 et seq., which is eligible to receive payments of twenty-five
28	thousand dollars (\$25,000) three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) or more
29	for services supplied as a Medicaid provider shall, as a condition of
30	enrollment, provide the Department of Human Services with an annual financial
31	and compliance audit. The audit shall cover the entire operations of the
32	nonprofit organization and be in accordance with the Guidelines for Financial
33	and Compliance Audits of Programs Funded by the Arkansas Department of Human
34	Services as promulgated by the Arkansas Department of Human Services.
35	(b) Every nonprofit corporation licensed under $ ilde{\Box}$ 20-9-201 et seq.
36	which is eligible to receive payments of twenty-five thousand dollars

- 1 (\$25,000) three hundred thousand dollars or more for services supplied as a
- 2 Medicaid provider shall, as a condition of enrollment, provide the Department
- 3 of Human Services with an annual financial audit. The audit shall cover the
- 4 entire operations of the organization and be in accordance with the
- 5 Guidelines for Financial and Compliance Audits of Programs Funded by
- 6 the Arkansas Department of Human Services.
- 7 (c) The Arkansas Department of Human Services is specifically
- 8 authorized to promulgate regulations establishing subrecipient and
- 9 provider audit requirements for all programs funded through the
- 10 Arkansas Department of Human Services."

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- 12 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
- 13 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
- 14 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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- 16 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
- 17 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
- 18 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
- 19 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
- 20 act are declared to be severable.

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- 22 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
- 23 hereby repealed.

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
